# FIREPIT INSTALLATION

(APPLICABLE TO BOTH ROUND AND SQUARE FIREPITS)



STEP 1

Choose a location that is level and away from your house and low hanging trees or branches.

**For Round:** Place the base ring down for a template. Mark a circle 2" from the outside diameter. Remove the base ring when clearly marked.

**For Square:** Measure a 48"x48" square and clearly mark.



STEP 2

Dig out the circle and level out the soil approximately 3-4" deep. Remove the sod and dirt to a depth of 3-4".



STEP 3

Compact the soil using a hand tamper. Tamp down substrate (soil) keeping it level. Check the area with a level. Adding and removing soil as needed, tamp again.



STEP 4

Place clean small gravel (#9 or #89 grave/stone) 2.5-3" deep.



STEP 5

Tamp down gravel/ stone keeping it level.



STEP 6

Place first course and use rubber/plastic mallet to establish a level bottom course.



STEP 7

Continue to install the interlocking pieces 3 layers high. No adhesive needed.



STEP 8

Fill the outer perimeter with the small gravel. Complete with putting on the four piece caps. Adhesive is optional.
